### All PCA-MBR Events August 13 – 16, 2009

**\*\*\*\*Important – if you purchased the corral package – you MUST have your Corral Parking Pass in your windshield before you enter Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca. If you did not elect and pay to receive your Corral Parking Pass by FedEx, you must pick up your packet at the Thursday 8/13 or Friday 8/14 Club Events – PACKETS WILL NOT BE PLACED IN MAZDA RACEWAY LAGUNA SECA’S WILL CALL @ EMBASSY SUITES\*\*\*\***

Goodie bags, t-shirts, goodie store items and tickets for all other events can be picked up at the club events on Thursday 8/13, Friday 8/14 or at “Porsche Island” in the Porsche Corral at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca on Saturday/Sunday 8/15 -16. Should decide to attend an event, a limited number of tickets may be available at the event (based on space available).

**Driving Tour Start Point:** Main Gain Entrance to Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca, 1021 Monterey-Salinas Highway (Highway 68), Salinas, CA 93901.

2	North County	The interface of civilization and wildland, with emphasis on the area around Elkhorn Slough.	50.3	1 hour
3	Peninsula	Historical and cultural highlights of coastal cities.	27.25	1.5 hours + return to peninsula

“Estimated Time” = travel time, at or below posted speeds, with no rest or sightseeing stops.

Last names beginning in A – D	Arrive at registration <b>9 am</b>
Last names beginning in E – L	Arrive at registration <b>10 am</b>

Last names beginning in S – Z	Arrive at registration <b>12 noon</b>

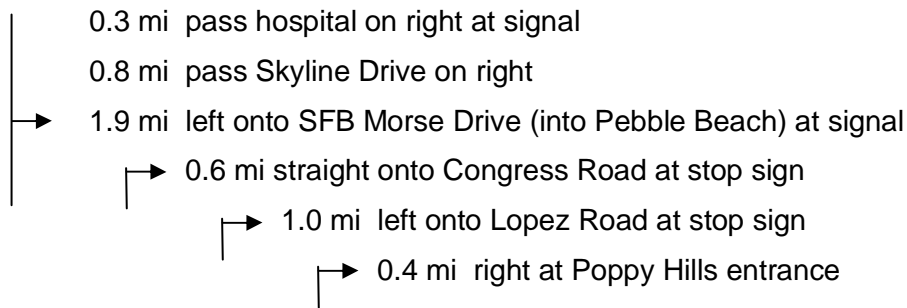
**General Packet Pick-up:** Packets for any participant will be available from 9 am – 1 pm at the Driving Tour start point (see above)

Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca spectator gates open at 7 am. Plan to arrive early as traffic will be congested. Driving instructions are on the **GREEN** sheets in your packet. Even if you think you know which entrance to use, please follow the instructions provided. Please follow all vehicle control and corral parking personnel instructions. SCRAMP and the corral folks are all volunteers, and we want you to get to your proper location.

PCA-MBR hospitality will be open Saturday & Sunday on “**Porsche Island**” (aka BBQ Island). Please check in at the registration tent to get your wristband for the hospitality area. You will need your Hospitality Ticket and wristband to enter **Porsche Island**. (**Any wristband removed will be void and will not allow reentry**).

Our corral parking area will be the in **GREEN 4 and 5** areas on the track map below. By following the traffic directions provided, you will be entering the facility at TC-1 – the intersection just below the **Red 8** parking area.

Porsche is working on scheduling presentations on “**Porsche Island**”. We will have additional information available at the registration area at “**Porsche Island**” Saturday & Sunday.

Lunches on Saturday and Sunday will be served from 11:30 – 1:30 on **Porsche Island**.

Sunday Parade lap is estimated to occur during the lunch time break. On Sunday – please begin lining up in the Parade lap staging area – As you turn into the lakebed/corral area at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca, you

will make an immediate left turn. You should see **Porsches** already in place to pull behind. The driver and all vehicle passengers **MUST** sign a PCA waiver, a Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca waiver and wear the parade lap wristband to participate in the parade lap. (a parent will be required to sign a waiver for a any driver or passenger under 18 years of age.) Upon signing the waivers, you will be issued a wristband. You and your vehicle **MUST BE** lined up and ready to go by 11:45 am Sunday morning. **REMEMBER** – this is a parade lap with approximately 300 cars – not a high speed driving event – so please keep it safe when you are on the race track.

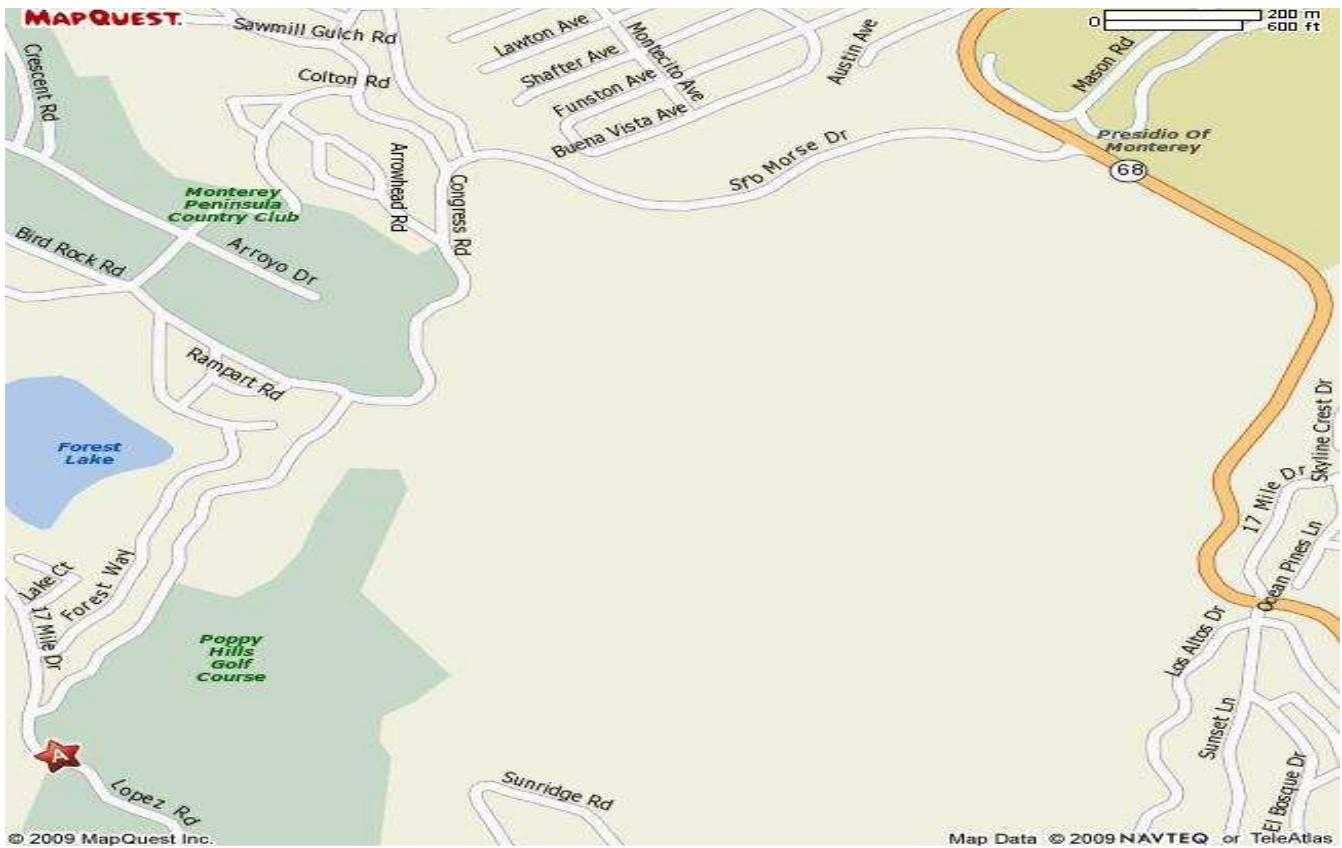
